Oscarware, Inc., was co-founded in 1989 by Debra Dudley and her late husband, "Reg." Together, they invented a product they called "Grill Topper". Little did they know that this ingenious product would reinvent outdoor grilling forever.

Following the success of the Grill Topper, Oscarware expanded its product line to include disposable, one-time-use items designed for convenience. They now offer a range of products for grilling hot dogs, ribs, and turkey, as well as a griddle for making pancakes.

Oscarware collaborates with prestigious brands such as Walmart, Char-Broil, and Big Green Egg,

and has plans to expand globally.

In May of 2024, the U.S. Department of Commerce honored Oscarware with the President's "E" Award, recognizing their contribution to increasing U.S. exports.

They can be found in Bonnieville, KY, where they have called home since its inception. Debra Dudley shared that Bonnieville is a special place, holding memories as well as a rich history for the company.

Aluminium coils are fed through a large stamping press that cuts out holes, allowing for even heat distribution during the grilling process. Pieces that are destined for the coating process are then put on a conveyor and sent down the line.



A machine controls the dry electrostatic process within the 72-foot oven that takes 15 minutes from entering to exiting. During this process, the porcelain coating (added during a previous step in the process) is cured at 1535°, making it food safe and durable in extreme heat.



As the parts exit the oven, they are inspected by quality control, boxed, and shipped to places like Walmart and across 14 other countries.
